Recently we have had a students represent themselves and our school at state events. These students should be very proud of their achievements as we as a school community are.

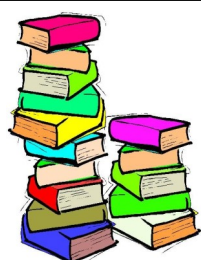

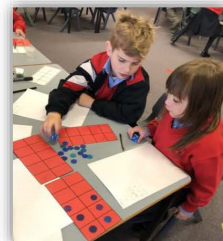
HEAD LICE
