## STAGE 2

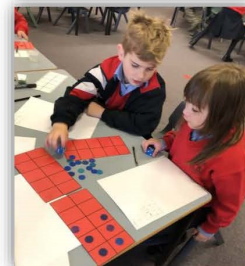
Stage 2 will be going to Parkes pool on Wednesday, please remember swim wear and a towel. Some children may like to bring goggles and swim cap.
