Term 3 Personal Best Award Winner

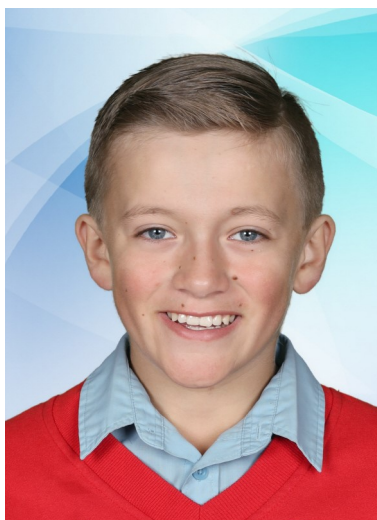
Kade Ticehurst - 5/6H

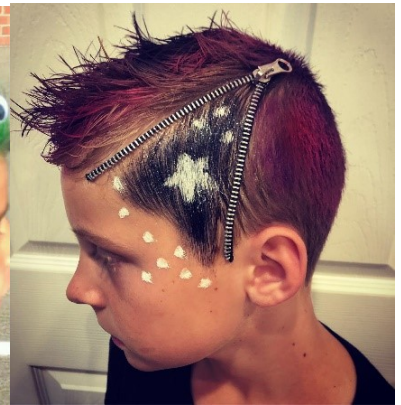
