PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) will take place this week for our students in Years 3 and 5. The tests assess the foundational skills in reading, writing, spelling and numeracy that are essential for every child to progress through school and life.

NAPLAN data is used to help monitor student progress over time against a national measure and to identify areas of strength and improvement. It is used in combination with other school assessments to guide and support student learning.

We have noticed students arriving before 8:40am. Our school day begins at 8:40am and there is no active supervision before this time. We encourage students to arrive after 8:40am for their safety.

It is important that schools continue to follow COVID 19 GUIDELINES

- Staff and students should not attend work or school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms should be sent home and should not return until they have received a negative test result and are symptom-free. In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.
- Anyone who is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms are strongly encouraged to get tested and self-isolate until a negative result is received.
- Staff and visitors to schools and offices should maintain 1.5m distance from other people where practicable. Avoid congestion of groups of visitors in specific areas where possible.
- All visitors to a school site must comply with sign-in arrangements for each visit. This includes signing the school sign-in sheet to acknowledge that they will comply with the COVID-19 requirements for visitors, contractors and service providers. Visitors must also check in using the Service NSW QR code




