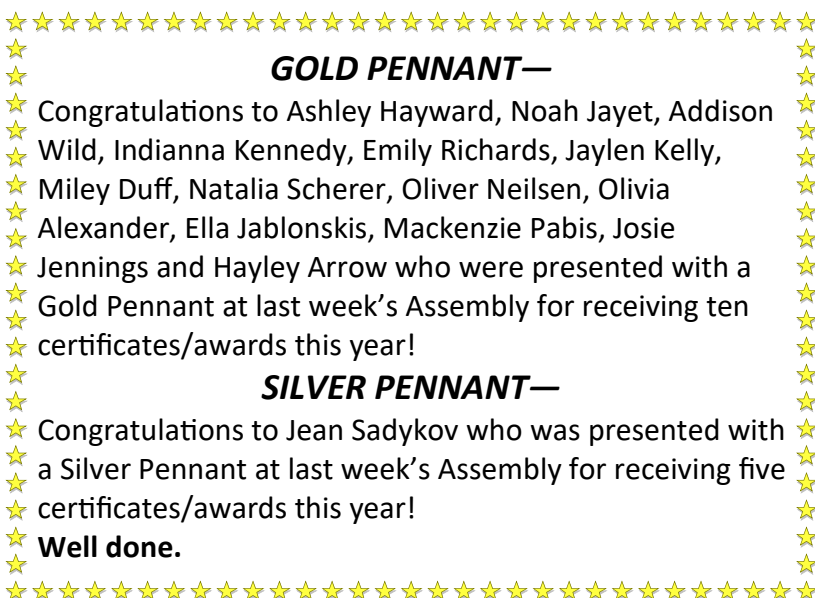

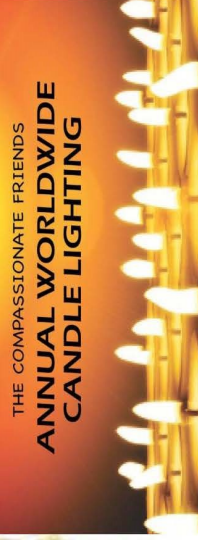

Candles will be lit and poems will be read at 6 pm.

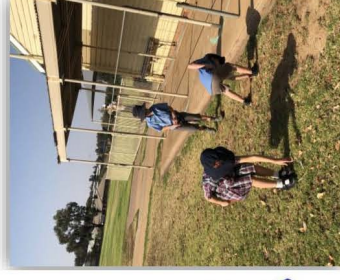
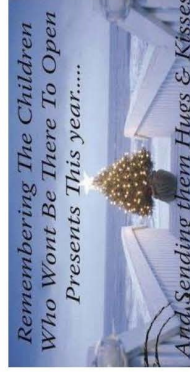
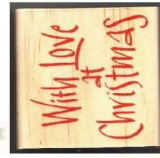
*We will have our 'Christmas Tree photo board' of our children we have loved and lost. You are invited to **bring a photo of your child** to add to our board.*
